On May 7, 2019, Anthony D. Grable plead guilty to these 8 charges. Today, District Court Judge T. Kelly Ryan issued him a life sentence in this case. He will not be eligible for parole for 50 years.

This case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorneys Josh Brunkhorst and Lannie Ornburn.

The Overland Park Police Department and the Johnson County Sheriff's Office Criminalistics Laboratory are the investigating agencies. Assistance was provided by federal authorities including the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms and the US Marshals Service

Anthony D. Grable, 32, of Kansas City, Missouri, has been charged with premeditated first degree murder, attempted premeditated first degree murder, three counts of aggravated assault, two counts of aggravated robbery, and one count of burglary in Johnson County District Court case number 18CR1782.

These charges stem from a shooting that took place on July 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2018 outside of the Sunrise Point Elementary School as well as subsequent robberies and a burglary that took place shortly after the shooting.

**Anthony D. Grable should be presumed innocent until proven guilty.**
