Johnson County District Court Judge Brenda Cameron has sentenced William D. Luth to 495 months (41.25 years) in the custody of the Kansas Department of Corrections.

The case was prosecuted by District Attorney Steve Howe and Assistant District Attorney Jason Covington.

Co-defendant, Brady A. Newman-Caddell's case 16CR2590 is pending.

Johnson County District Attorney Steve Howe announces that William D. Luth pleaded guilty as charged today in Johnson County District Court case 16CR2589. The complaint filed included charges of: aggravated kidnapping, two counts of rape, and aggravated criminal sodomy.

Luth's sentencing is scheduled for 02/15/2018.

The case was investigated by the Olathe Police Department, the Independence, Missouri Police Department, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Johnson County Sheriff's Office and the Johnson County Criminalistics Laboratory.
