Updated: December 13, 2017

Today, on day 3 of his jury trial, Nicquan Ke-Aaron Midgyett, pleaded guilty as charged to include counts of first degree murder, attempted aggravated robbery, and conspiracy to commit aggravated robbery. Midgyett had previously pleaded guilty to aggravated battery in this case. Midgyett will be sentenced on March 8, 2018.

Updated: August 25, 2017

Judge Timothy McCarthy has sentenced Hakeem Malik, Jr. to life in prison, without the possibility of parole for 25 years, for his role in the homicide of Jon Bieker at She’s a Pistol in Shawnee, Kansas on January 9, 2015.

This case was investigated by the Shawnee Police Department and the Johnson County Crime Lab and prosecuted by Assistant District Attorneys Vanessa Riebli and Jacob Gontesky.

Updated: May 25, 2017

Hakeem Malik, Jr. has pleaded guilty to first degree murder, attempted aggravated robbery, conspiracy to commit aggravated robbery, and aggravated battery in the complaint filed in his case, 15CR77. Sentencing is scheduled for August 25, 2017 at 1:30 p.m.

Updated: May 18, 2017

A jury has found Londro Emanuel Patterson, III guilty of first degree murder, attempted aggravated robbery, conspiracy to commit aggravated robbery, and aggravated battery in this case. Sentencing is scheduled for July 21, 2017. The case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorneys Vanessa Riebli and Jacob Gontesky.

Date: January 12, 2015

The Johnson County Kansas District Attorney’s Office announces on January 11, 2015, four individuals were charged with felony murder in the January 9, 2015, death of Jon Bieker at “She’s a Pistol”, a business in Shawnee, Kansas.
