JOHNSON COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY CHARGES KELLI JO BAUER

WITH FELONY THEFT

Today, Johnson County District Attorney Steve Howe charged Kelli Jo Bauer in Johnson County District Court case number 15CR789.

This charge stems from an investigation initiated by the Overland Park Police Department after officers were provided information that she was advertising the sale of high end women's clothing on Facebook swap and shop sites.

Kelli Jo Bauer is charged with one count of felony theft with a value of \$100,000 or more. Her bond is currently set at \$50,000. She will have a first appearance in Johnson County District Court today at 1:30 p.m in Division M4.

The case is being investigated by detectives with the Overland Park Police Department's Organized Retail Crime Unit.

Kelli Jo Bauer should be considered innocent until proven guilty.
