On April 18, Harold Benton Cyphers, III, of Independence, Missouri, plead guilty to the five felony charges in this case:

- Count 1 - Involuntary Manslaughter while DUI - 104 months
- Count 2 - Involuntary Manslaughter while DUI - 43 months
- Count 3 - Identity Theft (9 months)
- Count 4 - Felony Theft (7 months)
- Count 5 - Poss. of Meth (12 months)

All counts will run consecutive for a total sentence of 175 months in the Kansas Department of Corrections.

The Leawood Police Department and the Johnson County Sheriff's Office Criminalistics Laboratory were the investigating agencies.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorneys Ann Henderson and Aubrey Wilson.

Harold Benton Cyphers, III, 36 years of age, of Independence, Missouri, has been charged with two counts of involuntary manslaughter while DUI, ID theft, felony theft, felony possession of methamphetamine, misdemeanor possession of drug paraphernalia, felony driving while suspended, no insurance, and violating traffic control signal in Johnson County District Court case number 16CR2207

Cyphers is charged with causing a motor vehicle collision at State Line Road and 119th Street in Leawood, Kansas on July 3, 2016 that resulted in the deaths of William and Donna Manning of Overland Park.
