**JOHNSON COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY SEIZES HOME FURNISHINGS
CONSIGNMENT STORE, ADVISES VICTIMS TO FILE CLAIMS**

Johnson County District Attorney Steve Howe has filed a lawsuit against Great Finds Consignment Home Furnishings & Gifts and its owner Dana J. Cox alleging the business violated the Kansas Consumer Protection Act. The business, located at 8722 Santa Fe Drive in Overland Park, sold home furnishings on consignment and conducted estate sales.

The lawsuit alleges that consumers were unable to retrieve their items when the store closed. It also alleges that some individuals were not timely compensated by the business when their items were sold.

The DA's Office has taken possession of the store, and has been granted the right to begin distributing items located within the store that were consigned by the public. If you believe you have items located at the business that you would like to retrieve, you are urged to immediately contact the Johnson County District Attorney's Consumer Hotline at 913-715-3003 to file a complaint and make a claim.
