Today, Angelo Vincenzo Monteleone became the third individual to plead guilty to murder charges involving the death of 17 year old Daniel Bowden on June 15, 2018 at 105 S. Clairborne Road in Olathe. Mr. Monteleone pled guilty to Murder in the Second Degree, Conspiracy to Commit Aggravated Robbery, and Attempted Aggravated Robbery in District Court case 18CR1623.

Previously, Isaiah Wisinger (19CR769) and Caesar Herrera (18JV729) had pled guilty and been sentenced for their involvement in the death of Mr. Bowden. Malik Delva (18CR1633) also faces charges from the same incident, but his case remains pending. Mr. Delva is presumed innocent until proven guilty.

Monteleone's sentencing is scheduled for October 16, 2019 at 11:00 a.m. in Division 13 of the Johnson County Courthouse.

This case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorneys William F. Hurst, IV and Peter R. Glasser.

The case was investigated by the Olathe Police Department and Johnson County Criminalistics Laboratory, with assistance from the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department.
