Johnson County District Court Judge Brenda Cameron has sentenced Brady Allen Newman-Caddell to 660 months (55 years) in the custody of the Kansas Department of Corrections. This is the maximum sentence allowed by law.

The case was prosecuted by District Attorney Steve Howe and Assistant District Attorney Jason Covington.

Johnson County District Attorney Steve Howe announces that Brady Allen Newman-Caddell pleaded guilty as charged today in Johnson County District Court case 16CR2590. The complaint filed included charges of aggravated kidnapping, two counts of rape, and aggravated criminal sodomy.

The case was investigated by the Olathe Police Department, the Independence, Missouri Police Department, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Johnson County Sheriff's Office and the Johnson County Criminalistics Laboratory.
