What is the Juvenile Victim Impact Panel?

The Juvenile Victim Impact Panel is an opportunity for victims of crime to tell young offenders about their experiences and how it has affected their lives, the lives of their families, and their community. Research has shown that face-to-face meetings between juvenile offenders and victims has lowered the recidivism rate of those juveniles and has made those juveniles more likely to fulfill their restitution obligations.
