On August 19, 2022, a jury found Robert Lee Harris guilty of First Degree Premeditated Murder in the death of Tanisha Harris, in case number 18CR00073. This case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorneys Megan Ahsens and Daniel Obermeier, with the assistance of the Overland Park Police Department and the Johnson County Crime Lab. This case is set for sentencing on November 3, 2022 at 1:30 pm.

Date: January 10, 2018

Robert Lee Harris, 30, of Overland Park, Kansas, has been charged with First Degree Premeditated Murder in Johnson County District Court case number 18CR00073.

Bond is currently set at \$1,000,000.

Harris will have his first appearance in District Court at 1:30 p.m. on January 11, 2018 in Division M4.

On January 8th, 2018, at approximately 4:07 p.m., officers were dispatched to an address in Overland Park, Kansas, in response to a 911 call. Officers interviewed Robert Harris, who later confessed to killing Tanisha Harris.

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Michael McElhinney.

The Overland Park Police Department, the Johnson County Sheriff's Office Criminalistics Laboratory, and the Johnson County District Attorney's Office are the investigating agencies.
