On May 2, 2022, a jury found Devonte Dominique Wash guilty of Capital Murder in the death of Ashley Harlan and her unborn child, in case number 18CR1128. This case was prosecuted by District Attorney Steve Howe and Assistant District Attorney Marissa Bell, with the assistance of the Olathe Police Department and the Johnson County Crime Lab. This case is set for sentencing on June 24, 2022 at 10:00 am.

**Date: April 26, 2018**

Devonte Dominique Wash, 26, of Kansas City, Kansas, has been charged with Capital Murder in Johnson County District Court case number 18CR1128.

Bond is currently set at \$5,000,000.

Wash will have his first appearance in District Court at 1:30 p.m. on April 27, 2018 in Division M4.

On January 30th, 2018, at approximately 4:00 p.m., officers were dispatched to the 1200 block of East Westerfield Place in Olathe, Kansas, in response to a 911 call. Upon arrival, officers located 23 year old Ashley Harlan dead inside the residence.

This case is being prosecuted by District Attorney Steve Howe and Assistant District Attorney Vanessa Riebli.

The Olathe Police Department, the Johnson County Sheriff's Office Criminalistics Laboratory, and the Johnson County District Attorney's Office are the investigating agencies.
