Update: March 29, 2023

On March 29, 2023, the honorable Christina Dunn Gyllenberg sentenced Dvonte Jamal Brown in case number 20CR882 for Count I First-Degree Murder to life in prison without the possibility of parole for 25 years; and for Count II, Attempted Second Degree Murder to 59 months. The sentences are to run concurrently.

Update: January 18, 2023

On January 17, 2023, a jury found Dvonte Jamal Brown guilty of First-Degree Murder in the death of Micah A. Babick, through case number 20CR00882. This case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorneys Daniel Obermeier and Kinsella Brunetti, with the assistance of the Overland Park Police Department and the Johnson County Crime Lab. This case is set for sentencing on March 29, 2023.

Date: April 13, 2020

Dvonte Jamal Brown, 27, has been charged with First Degree Murder in Johnson County District Court case number 20CR882.

On April 8, 2020, officers were dispatched to the Johnson County Public Library in Overland Park in reference to an armed disturbance. When they arrived, they located Micah A. Babick deceased in the parking lot.

The arrest was the result of an investigation by the Overland Park Police Department and the Johnson County Crime Lab.

Bond is currently set at \$1,000,000. He will have his first appearance by video in District Court at 1:30 p.m. today.
