On July 31, 2022 the Overland Park police department was dispatched to the BP gas station at 8698 College Blvd on a shots fired call. Officers responded to the scene and found Shaquille J. Jackson seriously wounded. He was taken to a local hospital where he died from his injuries. Witnesses stated that the suspect left in a Toyota Highlander prior to officer arrival.

ZARRELL SEMAJ FINLEY, 25, has been charged with First Degree Murder and Possession of Firearm by Felon in Johnson County District Court case number 22CR2109.

His bond is currently set at \$500,000 and his first appearance will be in District Court on November 1, 2022 at 1:30 pm in Division M4.

The arrest was the result of an investigation by the Overland Park Police Department.
