Today, Johnson County District Court Judge Brenda Cameron sentenced Jacob R. Chaney to 207 months in custody of the Kansas Department of Corrections. This sentence will run consecutive to his two Wyandotte County District Court cases. Chaney was also ordered to pay \$24,173.92 in restitution.

March 9, 2020

On March 6, 2020, Jacob R. Chaney, 29, of Kansas City, Kansas, pled guilty to attempted second degree murder, aggravated assault, felon in possession of a firearm, three counts of auto burglary, felony fleeing and eluding, and felony theft in Johnson County District Court case 19CR1682. These charges were a result of a shooting that occurred in Prairie Village on June 15, 2018 and an aggravated burglary and police pursuit in Fairway on October 14, 2017.

Sentencing is set for June 4, 2020 at 11:00am.

The case was investigated by the Prairie Village Police Department, Fairway Police Department, the Johnson County Crime Lab, and the Kansas City, Kansas Police Department. Assistant District Attorneys Vanessa Riebli and Xavier Andrews prosecuted the case on behalf of the State.
