The Honorable Thomas M. Sutherland has sentenced James Loganbill to 12 months in jail and denied defendant's motion for probation. This is the maximum sentence allowed by law. The court also found that the crime was sexually motivated and required sex offender registration for a period of 15 years.

James Loganbill was found guilty today of reckless stalking of a minor child in Johnson County District Court case number 20CR1336 by Judge Thomas M. Sutherland. This case was the result of an investigation into the actions of this Olathe School District teacher towards one of his students. Sentencing has been set for November 3, 2021 at 3:30 pm in District Court number 3.
