Johnson County District Attorney Steve Howe announces that his office has completed a review of the December 21, 2016, officer-involved shooting in Overland Park, Kansas at approximately 4:30 a.m.

It is the determination of the District Attorney that the Overland Park Police officer's use of force was justified under Kansas law. Therefore, no criminal action will be taken against him.

This case was investigated by the Johnson County Multi-jurisdictional Officer Involved Shooting Investigation Team (OISIT).
