**Update: August 23, 2023**

On August 23, 2023, the honorable Thomas M. Sutherland sentenced Patricia Ann Myler in case number 22CR00342 to 24 months in prison for Count I, Mistreatment of a Dependent Adult, 6 months in prison for Count IV, Mistreatment of a Dependent Adult, and 24 months in prison for Count V, Mistreatment of a Dependent Adult. Counts I and V are to run consecutive to each other for a controlling sentence of 48 months. This case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Marissa Bell.

This arrest was the result of a collaborative investigation by the Kansas Department for Children and Families' Adult Protective Services division, Olathe Police Department, and the Johnson County District Attorney's Office. This sentencing brought to conclusion one of the most complex and multi-faceted financial mistreatment investigations handled by this office.

PATRICIA ANN MYLER, 39, has been charged with seven counts of Mistreatment of an Elder Person, six counts of Identity Theft, and three counts of Computer Crime targeting elderly residents at Villa St. Francis Nursing Home in Olathe while she was employed there. Johnson County District Court case number 22CR00342.

This investigation is ongoing. Patricia Ann Myler was identified to have worked at AdventHealth Care Center located at 6501 W. 75<sup>th</sup> St. Overland Park, KS from June 2018 until February 2019, and Villa St. Francis located at 16600 W. 126<sup>th</sup> St. Olathe, KS from March 2019 to December 2020.

Her bond is currently set at \$175,000 and her first appearance will be in District Court on February 7, 2022 at 1:30 pm in Division M4.
