Update: March 20, 2024

On March 20, 2024, the honorable Christina Dunn Gyllenborg sentenced Fernando Reyes-Lara in case number 22CR3342 to 285 months for Count I and 61 months for Count III. In case number 24CR152 to 54 months for Count I. The sentences in each case will run consecutively to each other for a controlling 400 month sentence.

Update: January 17, 2024

On January 17, 2024, Fernando Reyes-Lara pleaded guilty to Second Degree Intentional Murder, and two counts of Aggravated Robbery in the November 30, 2022, in death of Jarod Rogers through district court case numbers 22CR3342 and 24CR0152.

This case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorneys Daniel Obermeier and Kendall Kaut with the assistance of the Shawnee Police Department and the Johnson County Sheriff's Office Criminalistics Laboratory.

On November 30, 2022, police responded to a welfare check at a business in Shawnee, Johnson County, Kansas and found a person later identified as Jarod Rogers with a gunshot wound. Mr. Rogers passed away from his injuries on December 2, 2022.

The following individuals are now facing criminal charges related to his death. Those individuals are: 17-year-old Sabrina Clark, case number 22JV1081; 17-year-old Kyleigh

Guzman, case number 22JV1077; 17-year-old Roger Hernandez 22JV1079; 17-year-old Fernando Gonzalez-Prado, case number 22JV1080; and 18-year-old Fernando Reyes-Lara 22CR3342.

This investigation and charges were the result of the investigation by the Shawnee police department and the Johnson County Crime Lab.

Those charged should be presumed innocent until proven guilty.
