The Honorable Christina Dunn Gyllenborg has sentenced Miguel Perez-Ramirez to 86 months in prison. Restitution was ordered in the amount of \$13,173.75. Miguel Perez-Ramirez pleaded guilty on September 10, 2021 to five counts of DUI, Aggravated Battery/ Great Harm.

Miguel Perez-Ramirez, 30, has been charged with ten counts of DUI Aggravated Battery and two counts of Aggravated Child Endangerment in Johnson County District Court case number 20CR1515.

On June 28, 2020, at approximately 4:53 PM, officers from the Olathe Police Department responded to a multiple vehicle injury crash at the intersection of Old 56 Highway and Harrison St. Ten individuals were transported to area hospitals with injuries resulting from the crash.

The arrest was the result of an investigation by the Olathe Police Department and the Johnson County Crime Lab.

His bond is currently set at \$250,000.

Perez-Ramirez's first appearance in District Court is by video at 1:30 today.
