Johnson County District Attorney Steve Howe announces that Roger Dean Schimmel was sentenced in Johnson County District Court case number 19CR1860 for the convictions of Rape of a Child, Aggravated Indecent Liberties with a Child and Aggravated Indecent Liberties with a Child. Mr. Schimmel was found guilty of these charges after entering a plea on April 28, 2020. These charges stem from his sexual abuse of child that he was in contact with in Johnson County, Kansas between January 1, 2018 and July 17, 2019.

Mr. Schimmel received a 265 month sentence. Mr. Schimmel will be subject to lifetime post release supervision and is required to register as a sex offender for the remainder of his life.

The case was investigated by the Johnson County Sheriff's Office and prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Jason Covington.
