**JOHNSON COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY WARNS RESIDENTS
ABOUT COUNTERFEIT WORLD SERIES TICKETS**

Johnson County District Attorney Steve Howe warns residents not to fall victim to purchasing bogus World Series tickets either through Craigslist or in person.

Yesterday, the Overland Park Police Department arrested a total of four individuals. Three of the four suspects came here from New York, and the other one is from Atlanta. They have been charged in Johnson County District Court case numbers 14CR2350, 14CR2351, 14CR2352, and 14CR2353 and will all make their first court appearance today at 1:30. They are each currently being held on \$100,000 bonds.

The Overland Park Police Department believes there are more victims who bought bogus tickets from these individuals.

The District Attorney's Office urges residents to make direct contact with the Overland Park Police Department at (913) 895-6300 if they think they may have purchased counterfeit tickets.
