HANDLING TRAFFIC TICKETS DURING THE OFFICE'S CLOSURE TO THE PUBLIC
DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC**

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Johnson County District Attorney's Office is not open to the general public. Per Administrative Order 20-02, all traffic court dates scheduled between now and May 8th, 2020 have been rescheduled. If you would like to handle your traffic ticket between now and your court date, many traffic citations can be diverted. To inquire if your case is eligible for diversion, please check our website at www.da.jocogov.org or contact the Johnson County District Attorney's Traffic Diversion Unit at 913-715-3011. We will do our best to handle all divertible traffic cases via mail, email, fax or phone call.

The standard \$20.00 fee for mail in traffic diversion will be waived during this pandemic period.
